The cost of the equipment is not included. .

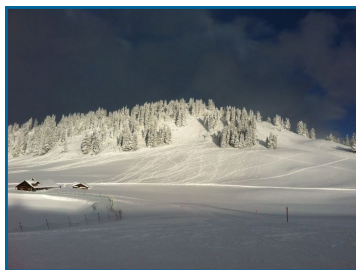
If you hire it, you need to pick it up the day before the outing

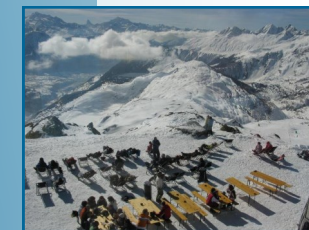

We strongly advise you to check that your personal accident insurance covers your activities in the mountains.



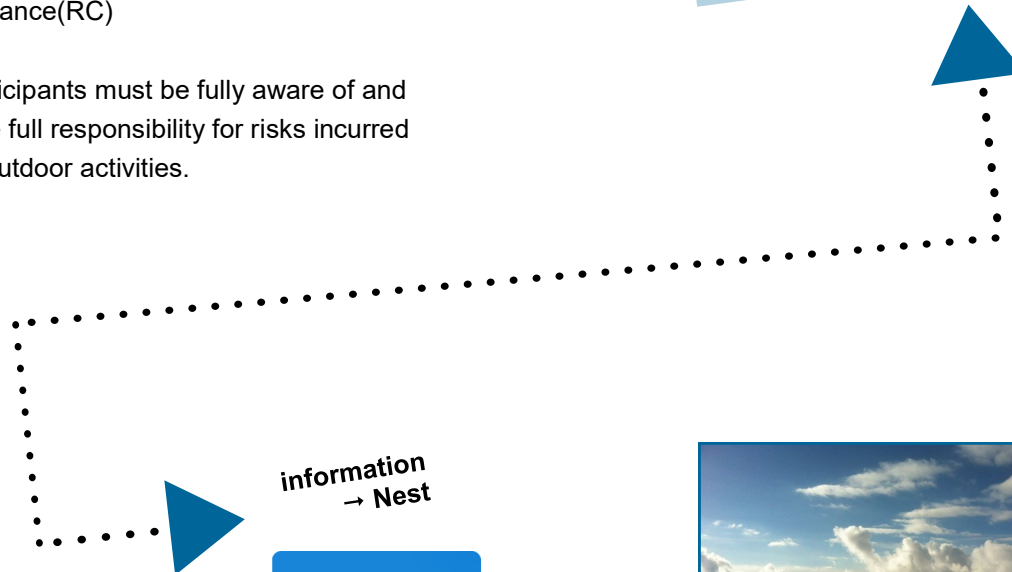
If not, we suggest that you take an "assurance complementaire" covering rescues in mountains (Rega, Air Glaciers, Helsana Top, etc. are some providers).
